PLAYERS PaintFest Murals to hang at Wolfson Children's Hospital

June 10, 2009, Jacksonville, FL -- On Friday, May 29th children from Community PedsCare, the pediatric palliative and hospice care program of Community Hospice of Northeast Florida who participated in the "These Kids Can Play PaintFest" during THE PLAYERS Championship, unveiled two murals in the Wolfson Children's Hospital lobby that will be displayed in a designated area of the hospital.

These two colorful murals, painted in THE PLAYERS Stadium Village and at the Jacksonville Landing during THE PLAYERS Downtown Experience throughout tournament week, depict scenes from TPC Sawgrass and feature the clubhouse and iconic 17th island green. Many of the children who participated in PaintFest at THE PLAYERS were themselves treated at Wolfson Children's Hospital.
