JAMESTOWN, N.C.—Furnitureland South announced Aug. 15 its partnership with the PGA TOUR Wives Association to renovate two spaces for Family Service of the Piedmont. The makeovers were performed in the lobby of the Slane Serve Center in High Point, N.C., and at one of the organization's battered women's shelters.

The lobby of the Slane Service Center is the first point of contact for clients in need of any of the numerous services offered by Family Service of the Piedmont. The battered women's shelter provides a home to a number of women and children who have fled violent and abusive, domestic situations.

Furnitureland South refurbished the shelter's living room/TV area, as well as the children's playroom—both common areas used daily. These rooms that received new furnishings and wall coverings provide an updated, more comfortable environment for clients seeking shelter.
