## **Nationwide Tour Wives to Support Fisher House and Families of the Armed Forces During Melwood Prince George's County Open**

**-- "Comfort of Home Baskets" to be Delivered to Andrews Air Force Base on June 2nd --**

PONTE VEDRA BEACH, FLA. - The PGA TOUR Wives Association will support the Fisher House and Families of the Armed Forces by producing and donating "Comfort of Home Baskets" during the upcoming Nationwide Tour's Melwood Prince George's County Open (June 1-6).

Tour wives of Nationwide Tour members will spearhead a drive among their organization, tournament volunteers and patrons to produce as many baskets containing essential living needs as possible. Fisher House provides a "home away from home" for military families when a family member is being treated for illness, injury or disease.

Carolyn Herman, wife of Nationwide Tour winner Jim Herman, is chairing the effort on behalf of the Nationwide Tour Wives Association.

Among the wish list of items the Wives Association are seeking are books, puzzles, throw blankets, family DVDs, nail polish/manicure items, bath salts/shower scrubs and lotions/aromatherapy oils for women. Additionally, they will be seeking small electronic games, DVDs (age up to 16), crosswords/word search mad libs books, coloring/sticker books, crayons/markers/colored pencils, board games, stickers, sketch pads, small toys and puzzles for children.

The Tour Wives will travel from the host University of Maryland Golf Course in College Park, Md. to nearby Andrews Air Force Base on Wednesday morning, June 2<sup>nd</sup> to deliver the "Comfort of Home Baskets" to the Fisher House and provide lunch for the families of the Armed Forces there.

The 2010 edition of the Melwood Prince George's County Open is being played at the University of Maryland Golf Course for the first time. Golf Channel will air all four rounds of the Nationwide Tour event in the U.S. with the PGA TOUR distributing it to over 100 countries outside the U.S.
